### VISAS

Liberian Visas are required for a fee of \$131. Please refer to the Liberian Consulate's website in Atlanta, Georgia at [www.liberianconsulatega.com](http://www.liberianconsulatega.com) to secure all forms. The Liberian Consulate in Atlanta, Georgia will assist in processing VISAS for travelers, if needed and will host a travel clinic in January 2011.

### INOCULATIONS

All travelers must obtain a prescription for malarial prophylaxis medication prior to travel from their primary care physician. Certain of these medications need to be started 1-2 weeks prior to the travel date. The following are required vaccinations, which need to be completed as soon as possible:

- Yellow fever vaccine (**required**)
- Typhoid vaccine (**recommended**)
- Meningococcal vaccine (**recommended**)

Please note that all meetings dates and times are subject to change. You may call your area travel clinic for information on all other inoculations.
